• Exporting will generate a file and save it into your Downloads folder as shown in Figure 4. Copy this file onto a USB memory stick. (Do not alter the file or file name in any way. Doing so may cause it to be unreadable by the QuickDraw.)

- Eject the USB stick from your computer and insert it into QuickDraw controller.
- On the QuickDraw controller, go to the Field and Weather screen and click on the Import Grower Tree button in the bottom/left corner, as seen in Figure 5.
